GGFC Scholarship Application

Terms and Conditions

By accepting a Club scholarship, the parent and the player acknowledge their obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of the Club's scholarship awards program as set out herein:

1. The player agrees to play the entire season exclusively for the Club and understands the Club will not release the player or the player's card to any other entity.
2. Any non-Club select, guest, school, or other type of play must have the prior approval of the Club's coaching staff.
3. The player shall meet the general requirement to not miss a Club game, tournament, competition or event for participation in any non-Club game, tournament, competition, or event unless the player has received the prior approval of the Club's coaching staff.
4. The player shall meet the mandatory requirement to regularly attend practice sessions and games. The Club may withdraw the scholarship and remove the player from the roster without prior notice for failure to attend practices or games, failure to attend a game for an unsatisfactory reason, or persistent failure to attend practices or games.
5. The scholarship award will be applied to the travel program fee, and the balance of the fee must be paid according to the payment schedule as advised by the Club or as agreed in writing between the Player and the Club.
6. The scholarship award is not applied to uniform fees. All new players must purchase their uniform kit and additional amounts may also be due to the Club for tournaments, referee fees and other activities. All current players must have and wear all of their uniform kit (GGFC backpack, warm-up jacket and pants, B&W game jerseys, game shorts, yellow practice jerseys, practice shorts, yellow socks). If current players are missing kit pieces, they must have them by the start of the season.
7. Failure to pay any outstanding balance according to the agreed upon payment schedule may result in the player being considered "not in good standing" and may result in the player being suspended, and/or revocation of the scholarship.

Failure to comply with or fulfill any of the obligations outlined above may result in revocation of the scholarship award, and the player or the player's parent or guardian must promptly pay to the Club, on its demand, the full travel team fee.

Other Evidence of Financial Need

The Club's Scholarship Committee will award scholarships based upon documented proof of income. An income tax return (IRS Form 1040) is the preferred proof. If you are not required to file an income tax return, or an income tax return is not available, please complete the attached Affidavit of Income, which **must** be notarized.

Note that at the Club's discretion, additional documentation to support your income level may be requested. In fact, any additional evidence of your income level will help expedite processing of the award. This may include Food Stamp awards letters or letters verifying eligibility for school lunch or breakfast programs.

If there are other factors that you believe the GGFC Scholarship Committee should take into consideration in determining the level of scholarship award, please explain them on a separate sheet of paper and attach it to the signed application form.
